CLASSROOM PROCEDURES

The natural environment of a hands on learning classroom like a FACS class is often noisy and somewhat controlled chaos. Due to this natural environment I expect students to follow the routine we learn the first few weeks of class so that the learning environment will be enjoyable for everyone. It is also important for everyone's safety that all students' actions are safe and respectful. If a student takes actions that are disrespectful or unsafe for his/her self, peers, or teacher they will be disciplined accordingly.
